- 1. Those present discussed/brainstormed the information available and possible plans for the lake.
 - a. Jen congratulated the committee on our Engagement project as a sense of community will be critical in determining and implementing any plans for the lake.
 - b. Many present had not received the Fishery report provided to Pam by Jennifer. <u>Plan: Jennifer to provide the report to those present and all committee members.</u>
 - c. We don't have the results of the water testing. <u>Barb to communicate with Scott Provost asking for analysis of water testing.</u>
 - d. Lake Mason was Clear Lake (Characteristics of a Clear Lake are predominate fish Bass & Blue Gill, much aquatic vegetation. Navigation can be challenging due to vegetation.)
 - e. Lake Mason is now a Turbid Lake. (Characteristics of a Turbid Lake are predominate fish Crappie and Carp with very limited aquatic vegetation.)
 - f. To return to a Clear Lake we would need to drain the lake, probably for 1 full year, poison all the fish and restock.
 - g. Need to use the Survey done last year to determine what lake characteristics are most desired by those surveyed. And have meetings / discussions with those affected.
 - h. Requested: Jennifer share at the Annual meeting, 10 AM Saturday August 31:
 - a. Clear vs Turbide Lake characteristics
 - b. History of Lake Mason
 - c. Current state of Lake Mason as Turbid
 - d. Compare results of Survey (what do users want) to two types of lakes, Clear vs Turbid
 - e. Very simple description of what is needed if a Clear Lake status is desired
 - i. Possible timeline
 - ii. Data still needed
 - iii. Estimated cost
 - iv. Anticipated results
- 2. Committee discussed issues that were raised at the June 1st LMMD member meeting. Committee would like to recruit new members for our committee, those who had raised issues / made suggestions at the June meeting
 - a. Carp Tournament Objectives: Fun, awareness of lake issues, etc. Barb to reach out to Dan Hanko
 - b. Bouy placement and corresponding signage: Sally Danke had raised the issue June 1. Dave will reach out to Sally to invite her to join the committee.
 - c. Boating regulations. DNR Worden had shared that the Lake District could enact boating regulations. Committee would like the Board to have a vote on these regulations at the Annual meeting:

- i. Slow / no wake areas and or times
- ii. No Wake Boats on Lake
- d. Proper disposal of carp when caught
- 3. Progress Toward Goal Reps present reported on interaction with neighbors. To-date we have met with 40 neighbors for 37% completion

- Determine what will be reported by the Lake Improvement Committee at the Annual LMMD Meeting Labor Day weekend.

- Discuss how to handle those neighbors who Reps have not met with
- Progress by Dale in getting and installing campground fishing regulations signs. The Board has not yet paid the bill. Much confusion as to how to get this paid.
- Determining committee's next project was tabled until September LIC meeting
 - See minutes above for possible projects
 - o If water testing reveals nutrient management is needed LIC could work with county land management people in implementing actions
 - Shoreline Buffer zones if nutrients are from shoreland owners
 - Jim Brancel has had discussions with Bella Goose about installing a Buffer Zone
 - Dave D could contact Pat Kilbey and Dustin Grant asking if anyone has expressed interest in planting a Buffer Zone
 - Refer to county concerns if nutrients seem to be coming from land use inland from the lake
